

## **Vestry Minutes Summary (May 28, 2013)**

### **Financial Overview**

Report from Richard Rogers, Chairman of The Investment Committee, reporting that the invested account begun in August 2012 has made a return to date of over 8%.

### **Memorials Committee**

We received unanimous approval to purchase a large free-standing burner and pot for stove, soups, spaghetti, etc. Purchase will be offset by ECW (\$500), \$2,500 is gifts and \$1,500 fundraisers by the Senior Adults.

### **Preschool**

Security upgrades are progressing and Judy Ingram is moving her office downstairs.

### **Long Range Vision**

Retreat for Sub-Committees and staff occurred on May 17. Chris Gambill from The Center for Congregational Health led the mini-retreat.
